What we learned: The teacher told us that in this particular family (with daughters only) every day one of the girls is skipping school. Not attending school being very unusual in Fiarenana, Zahana inquired with the parents. They explained that this is indeed the case. The reason being simple: While the parents are out in the fields working all day, somebody has to take care of the little one, not in school yet. Not to single out one child as the designated caretaker, they felt the fairest thing to do was to task a different daughter every day to be in charge of their little sister at home.
